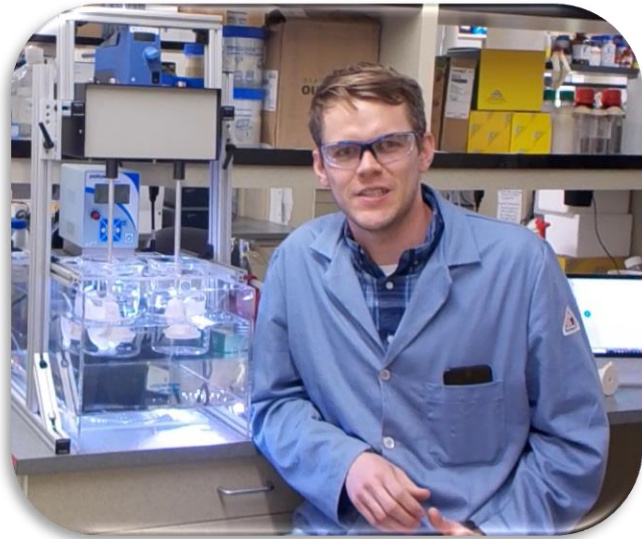


# Meet Christoph

Christoph Krumm is the founder of Sironix Renewables, a start-up company focused on developing environmentally friendly ingredients for cleaning products, like laundry detergents. Started in 2016, the company is working to make new soap molecules, called surfactants, from plant ingredients. Every day, Christoph and his coworkers invent soap molecules using new chemical reactions and test them using miniature laundry machines and small squares of fabric. Ultimately they hope to make cleaning products safer and more environmentally friendly.

As a college student at the University of Washington, Christoph discovered his love for science and engineering through a race car design and engineering program, where he designed a fuel system. While studying chemical engineering, Christoph developed an interest in biorenewable fuel technologies. This led him to graduate school at the University of Minnesota. While there, Christoph studied the conversion of plants into fuels and other useful chemicals. Near the end of graduate school, he took courses in entrepreneurship, which helped him in launching his company, Sironix Renewables.
